Family Participation Requirement:

North Kirra SLSC is a volunteer organisation. Our nippers program exists to educate and develop the skills of our junior members and provide them pathways to becoming patrolling members of North Kirra Surf Life Saving Club.

Following feedback from our Nipper community and with the support from the Surf Club Committee, there is a family participation requirement on our Nipper families. Our intention is to

spread the volunteer load across all our families and encourage all our families to take an active role in supporting our junior activities program. There are many ways to contribute to Nippers at North Kirra. Some of the common roles include the below. We thank those that has already committed to roles at the AGM held at the end of last season, but more helpers are needed, so let us know where you might be able to help out.

****** We understand that not everyone or family has the same capacity to assist, however participation is a requirement so that we can spread the load between all families. We are a friendly bunch at North Kirra and more than happy to provide assistance to everyone with any role they undertake, so please do not be discouraged by this requirement. We encourage you to speak to our Junior Activities team if the roles above are not suitable/possible for you.

PART 1 - SLSA Membership Renewals:

All membership renewals **MUST** be done online. This can be done through the SLS Hub at [SLS Hub - Login Screen](#)

TO RENEW:

Once logged in you may see a red section on the lefthand side with Action Required which you can follow through from there, or alternatively follow the below steps:

1. Click on the arrow beside More and Memberships, and click on family group to renew your family.
2. Click on Renew (unless you have to add a member to your group, of which you can click on Add Member and follow that process).
3. Select Season 2026/2027 from the drop down box
4. Put a tick (left hand side of the names) beside the names of the members you are renewing. Only tick those that will be joining/participating this season.
5. Tick the declaration and the bottom and click on Next
6. For each member, choose the relevant membership fee. For families, the first person will be the family fee (either nippers or patrolling dependent on whether anyone in the family patrols – only 1 member needs to patrol to receive that fee), and up to the next 3 members will be \$0 – included in family group. For any extra members, you will choose the extra person fee. If you are a family of less than 4, you will choose Associate member for any nipper parents, Active Senior for any parents that patrol and then junior/nipper for any children. Once fees are selected, click on Next.
7. If you are paying now, enter your card details.

8. If you are wanting to pay directly into the Club's bank account or another way (eg. Play On Vouchers), then choose Bank Transfer or Other – this won't ask for payment from you at that time.
9. Submit your renewal request, which will be sent to the club to approve (bank details will be shown there if you are paying by Bank Transfer).
10. If are redeeming a Play On Sport Voucher, please email a copy of the voucher to surfclub@northkirra.com.au and you can pay the balance into the bank account or via eftpos or cash at the club.
11. All memberships will be checked when received and will only be processed if all adult members have a Working with Children Blue Card and have completed the Child Safety Awards. A follow up email from the Club will come to either confirm everything is processed or to explain why it was not processed and what needs to be completed.

*** Please note, all adults that will accompany the junior members on the beach throughout the season must join as an Associate member of the Club or be a member of the Family Group, have a Blue Card and complete the online Child Safety Awards.*

Blue Cards/CYRM Inductions:

Renewing adult members should already have a Blue Card, however, yours may have expired, be expiring or you may not have one yet. If yours has expired or is expiring or you didn't get one last season, please arrange this as soon as possible – it is likely you will have received a reminder from Blue Card Services if you are in need of a renewal. **YOUR MEMBERSHIP CANNOT BE PROCESSED UNTIL THESE BLUE CARDS ARE IN PLACE (MEANING YOUR CHILD CANNOT START NIPPERS UNTIL YOUR BLUE CARD AND COURSES ARE SORTED).**

To renew or apply for a Blue Card, it is completed through an online process – please head to this website [Blue Card Services Applicant Portal](#). If you have completed a Blue Card application or renewal online before, you will be able to login, if you haven't you are initially registering for an online account.

1. ***Set up an account with Blue Cards & it will give you an account number – make a note of this number and send it to North Kirra SLSC as soon as possible so we can get the account linked to our organisation/surf lifesaving (you can't proceed with your application until this has been linked – you will receive a red message asking about your volunteer organisation if you have gone too far – you cannot proceed until your account has been linked)***

2. *Once it has been linked by SLSQ you will receive an email confirming the link. You can then complete the application by logging into the application portal (link contained within the email you will receive).*

Please note you need a Qld TMR Customer Reference Number to get a Qld Working with Children Blue Card, so if you only hold a driver's licence in NSW for example, you will need to attend a Qld Transport location to obtain a Customer Reference Number.

RELATED ONLINE COURSES:

In line with Blue Card Renewals and applications, you are required to complete/re-complete the Child Safety Award online. This is located within the new [Member Training Portal](#) (MTP). Once you are logged in, up the top you will see Membership, Financial, Child Safety Awards and Blue Card. If you hover over Child Safety Awards, you can click on the here to renew your award which will then open up the courses within the Safety and Wellbeing section and list them underneath the 8 big tabs. Enrol on the CSA/CYRMS course (it will only allow you to enrol if you are eligible). Alternatively you can click on Safety and Wellbeing and click on the CSA/CYRMS course.

Once enrolled, you will receive an email confirming your enrolment. To access the course to complete, there are 3 ways to do this:

1. Within the MTP, about 10-15 minutes after your enrolment, in the MTP and under Enrolled Courses and programs (not Workshops), it will display this enrolled course, and Show 1 x E-Learning, which you can click on to Go to Learner Portal. If you aren't logged into aXcelerate, you will need to log in. If you are already logged in, it will automatically take you there. To log in, click on Sign in with SLSA.
2. The email received will include a link to log into the SLSQ Education Learner Portal
3. Or Within the MTP, you can click on My Current Learning (aXcelerate) – from within the MTP (on the left hand side menu)

There is no need to send through confirmation this is completed as your profile will be automatically updated with these awards once the course is completed.

If you are not the primary family/adult member that created the family membership initially, you may not hold a SLS Hub Account to be able to complete this, so you will firstly need to create an account. If this is the case, please get in contact so that we can assist you with getting this set up.

PART 2- Supporters Club Renewals:

Upcoming Bronze Course:

Our first bronze course will get underway on Sunday 27 September and run for 6 consecutive Sunday mornings, with the assessment on November 1. If you know of anyone that would like to undertake the Bronze Course or you are interested in completing yourself to be able to do volunteer beach patrols or assist with nippers water safety, please note there will be some online theory components to complete prior to the commencement and they will have to complete a 400 metre pool swim in Under 9 minutes (supervised by a swim coach etc) prior to commencement (or we may be able to have this signed off at one of the nipper pool swims. To register interest, email surfclub@northkirra.com.au as soon as possible to get them enrolled and access all the information required.

Nipper Apparel:

You will be able to get your supplies of rashies, swimwear, caps etc at our Open/Sign On Day which is Sunday 13 September at North Kirra SLSC from 9am to 11am. There is then the opportunity to complete the pool swims at Palm Beach Aquatic Centre from 12pm to 2pm.

For those that don't come down to the Open/Sign On Day, you have the opportunity to attend the pool swim in Brisbane instead (or you can get this completed via the form with your child's swimming instructor) and uniforms can be purchased from the club from the first week of nippers, so please allow some extra time on the first few Sunday mornings if you need any items.

What's New this Season:

- The fees for the additional members to family memberships have been reduced
- Your season membership fee now includes a free sausage for every nipper at each nipper session they attend
- We will be hosting an Age Manager Induction/Training Day on Sunday 20 September to support our Age Managers and go over all the required information required to operate the program – we appreciate everyone's attendance at this.
