PART 1 - SLSA Membership Renewals:

All membership renewals **MUST** be done online. This can be done through the SLS Hub at [SLS Hub - Login Screen](#)

TO RENEW:

Once logged in you may see a red section on the lefthand side with Action Required which you can follow through from there, or alternatively follow the below steps:

1. Click on the arrow beside More and Memberships, and click on organisation or family group if you are renewing a family.
2. Click on Renew
3. Select Season 2026/2027 from the drop down box
4. Place a tick in the boxes of the people to renew (left hand side of the names)
5. Tick the declaration at the bottom and click on Next
6. For each member, choose the relevant membership fee
 - a) For families, the first person will be the family fee, and up to the next 3 members will be \$0 – included in family group. For any extra members, you will choose the extra person fee.
 - b) For singles, choose the correct fee for you – eg. Active/Long Service etc
7. Click on Next
8. If you are paying now, enter your card details.

9. If you are wanting to pay directly into the Club's bank account or another way (eg. Play On Vouchers), then choose Bank Transfer or Other – this won't ask for payment from you at that time
10. Submit your renewal request, which will be sent to the club to approve (bank details will be shown there if you are paying by Bank Transfer).
11. If are redeeming a Play On Sport Voucher, please email a copy of the voucher to surfclub@northkirra.com.au and you can pay the balance into the bank account or via eftpos or cash at the club.
12. All memberships will be checked when received and will only be processed if all adult members have a Working with Children Blue Card and have completed the Child Safety Awards. A follow up email from the Club will come to either confirm everything is processed or to explain why it was not processed and what needs to be completed.

Blue Cards/Child Safety Awards:

Renewing adult members should already have a Blue Card, however, yours may have expired, be expiring or you may not have one yet. If yours has expired or is expiring or you didn't get one last season, please arrange this as soon as possible – it is likely you will have received a reminder from Blue Card Services if you are in need of a renewal. **YOUR MEMBERSHIP CANNOT BE PROCESSED UNTIL THESE BLUE CARDS ARE IN PLACE (MEANING YOU EITHER CANNOT START PATROLS OR YOUR CHILD/REN CANNOT START NIPPERS UNTIL YOUR BLUE CARD AND COURSES ARE SORTED).**

To renew or apply for a Blue Card, it is completed through an online process – please head to this website [Blue Card Services Applicant Portal](#) :

- 1. Set up an account with Blue Cards & it will give you an account number – make a note of this number and send it to North Kirra SLSC so we can get the account linked to our organisation (you can't proceed with your application until this has been linked)***
- 2. Once it has been linked by SLSQ you will receive an email confirming the link. You can then complete the application by logging into the application portal (link contained within the document). If you are trying to proceed with your application as a Volunteer (which is what you need to do for this purpose) and it still says they require more information from the volunteer organisation, it means it has still not been linked yet, so you cannot proceed until it is.*

Please note you need a Qld TMR Customer Reference Number to get a Qld Working with Children Blue Card, so if you only hold a driver's licence in NSW for example, you will need to attend a Qld Transport location to obtain this number.

RELATED ONLINE COURSES:

In line with Blue Card Renewals and applications, you are required to complete/re-complete the Child Safety Award online. This is located within the new [Member Training Portal](#) (MTP). Once you are logged in, up the top you will see Membership, Financial, Child Safety Awards and Blue Card. If you hover over Child Safety Awards, you can click on the here to renew your award which will then open up the courses within the Safety and Wellbeing section and list them underneath the 8 big tabs. Enrol on the CSA/CYRMS course (it will only allow you to enrol if you are eligible). Alternatively you can click on Safety and Wellbeing and click on the CSA/CYRMS course.

Once enrolled, you will receive an email confirming your enrolment. To access the course to complete, there are 3 ways to do this:

1. Within the MTP, about 10-15 minutes after your enrolment, in the MTP and under Enrolled Courses and programs (not Workshops), it will display this enrolled course, and Show 1 x E-Learning, which you can click on to Go to Learner Portal. If you aren't logged into aXcelerate, you will need to log in. If you are already logged in, it will automatically take you there. To log in, click on Sign in with SLSA.
2. The email received will include a link to log into the SLSQ Education Learner Portal
3. Or Within the MTP, you can click on My Current Learning (aXcelerate) – from within the MTP (on the left hand side menu)

There is no need to send through confirmation this is completed as your profile will be automatically updated with these awards once the course is completed.

If you are not the primary family/adult member that created the family membership initially, you may not hold a SLS Hub Account to be able to complete this, so you will firstly need to create an account. If this is the case, please get in contact so that we can assist you with getting this set up.

PART 2 - North Kirra Supporters Club Renewals:

To register their interest, they need to email surfclub@northkirra.com.au as soon as possible so we can get them enrolled and provide all the information they need.

ONLINE SKILLS MAINTENANCE:

Skills Maintenance details for this season have now been released and it is available via the [Member Training Portal](#) (MTP).

To complete the online theory, click on Skills Maintenance 2026 and underneath the 8 tabs, you will see ***SLSA Skills Maintenance for the 2026/2027 season*** – click on that which will ask you to log into the SLSA National Etrainu system (same log in details). Click on and complete the skills maintenance section/s relevant to you from the following:

- Silver Medallion Patrol Captain – 1 scenario module
- Bronze Medallion – 6 short modules with videos
- Advanced Resuscitation Techniques – 4 short modules but some may already be completed from the Bronze/Resus sections
- IRB Crew – 2 modules with videos
- Observers – 1 short module
- Resuscitation – 2 short modules (again this will nearly all be completed from doing the bronze first)

- Silver Medallion IRB Driver – 4 short modules (a couple may already be completed from doing the IRBC)
- Surf Rescue Certificate – 3 short modules with videos

A reminder the online component will need to be completed prior to attending a practical session and you will need to enrol online into one of the sessions prior to attending. To enrol in the practical session, while you are in Etrainu completing the theory, click on Training Event, and head to the date you would like to attend and enrol in the session (just check the awards that are ticked as these indicate what you will be doing proficiency for).

Other Admin Items:

Remember to always update your profile with your current details – eg. home address, phone numbers, emails etc as this is where we get the information from to contact you. And if you have new drivers licence details and you hold any vehicle inductions or IRB driver awards, please ensure these are passed onto the club to update in your profile.
